1 Introduction

1.1 Overview

The **Early Bird Alerts** provide an advance indication of a potential trading opportunity or a potential watchlist candidate. They do not indicate a trade of themselves - additional techniques are applied to further qualify potential trades and the timing of any subsequent entry. These techniques are taught and documented in the Jump Start, Launch Pad, Nth Degree and Nth Degree+ products.

The Early Bird Alerts will work on any Meta Trader 4 platform.

Alerts, by email and/or dialog box, can be set for any of MT4's nine available timeframes on any loaded chart. These parameters can be individually or globally set at any time.

The Early Bird Alerts display window maintains a rolling list of the last 300 alerts received since the program was started.

Options are available:

- to generate a beep on receipt of a new alert
- for a minimised alert window to be automatically restored on receipt of a new alert
- for the alert window to display on top of other windows
- to hide the Long/Short and/or Price columns to increase the screen display area available for other programs
- to display the alerts with either the Server time provided by the broker or the Local time on your computer

These options are saved when the program closes and restored when the program restarts.

Forex Strategy Secrets provides two Alert packages, the Norwood Alerts and the Early Bird Alerts. These packages need to be written as MT4 Expert Advisors. As MT4 only allows one Expert Advisor to be attached to a chart, it is necessary to create two installations of MT4 and run the Norwood Alerts in one and the Early Bird Alerts in the other. The two MT4 installations would usually be on the same machine, but do not have to be.

If you notice the name of a broker in this documentation, it is not intended as a specific recommendation, it is simply the broker that was being used at the time the screenshots were taken.

In this documentation, the terms **symbol** and **currency pair** will be used interchangeably.

2 Installation

2.1 Stage 1 - Additional MT4 Installation

As mentioned in the Overview, Forex Strategy Secrets provides two Alert packages, the Norwood Alerts and the Early Bird Alerts. As both these packages need to be written as MT4 Expert Advisors and as MT4 only allows one Expert Advisor to be attached to a chart, it is necessary to create two installations of MT4 and run the Norwood Alerts in one and the Early Bird Alerts in the other. The two MT4 installations would usually be on the same machine, but do not have to be.

If you do not have a second installation of MT4, download one from your broker. The Early Bird Alerts would usually be run in a demo account but can be run in a live account if you so wish. Be aware that some brokers will automatically invalidate a demo account after a set period of time (for instance, a month) or after a period of inactivity (for instance, if there have been no trades for four weeks). You can normally get a new demo account from your broker without any trouble.

When installing as a standard user, please note that administrator rights will be required on Win 7 to complete the install of MT4 itself and the install of the Early Bird Alerts (regardless of whether or not the program is being installed in the appropriate Program Files directory structure or not).

Both MT4 and the Early Bird Alerts are 32-bit programs. On a 32-bit machine the standard Program Files directory is "Program Files". On a 64-bit machine, 64-bit programs are commonly installed into the "Program Files" directory and 32-bit programs are installed into the "Program Files(x86)" directory. MT4 can be installed into or outside the appropriate "Program Files" structure at your option. The Early Bird Alerts are actually installed inside their associated MT4 directory

When installing, it is suggested that you add "EBA" to the name of the folder you are installing into simply to make it easier to recognise which MT4 installation is to be used for the Early Bird Alerts. Make a note of the name of this folder, as this is the folder that the Early Bird Alerts will be installed into in the next Stage.

After installing MT4, when you are ready, delete all the default chart/feature/advertising windows that came with MT4 in the normal chart area - either click on the red close box on each window or press Ctrl+F4 repeatedly until they are all gone.

The Early Bird Alerts require Build 402 of MT4 as a minimum. The Build number can be found by running MT4 and selecting Help | About, but do not check it at this stage, as the Early Bird Alerts setup program will check for this when the Alerts are being installed and a warning will be issued then if necessary.

2.2 Stage 2 - Early Bird Setup Program

Please uninstall any existing beta version of this program before installing the current version.

Refer to the manual for details on how to uninstall this product.

When installing as a standard user, please note that administrator rights will be required on Win 7 to complete the install of MT4 itself and the install of the Early Bird Alerts (regardless of whether or not the program is being installed in the appropriate Program Files directory structure or not).

Please note that you cannot run two instances of the Early Bird Alerts at the same time on the one machine.

Download the Early Bird Alerts package (EarlyBirdAlerts_3.2.0.0.zip) from the <http://forexprofitclassroom.org> website and save it to your desktop or a temporary directory. The zip file contains two files, the PDF file for the Early Bird Alerts Manual and the installation file EarlyBirdAlerts_3.2.0.0_Setup.exe. Extract both files to a temporary directory. Read the Early Bird Alerts Manual, particularly the **Installation Stage 1 - Additional MT4 Installation** section and the **Stage 2 - Early Bird Setup Program** section.

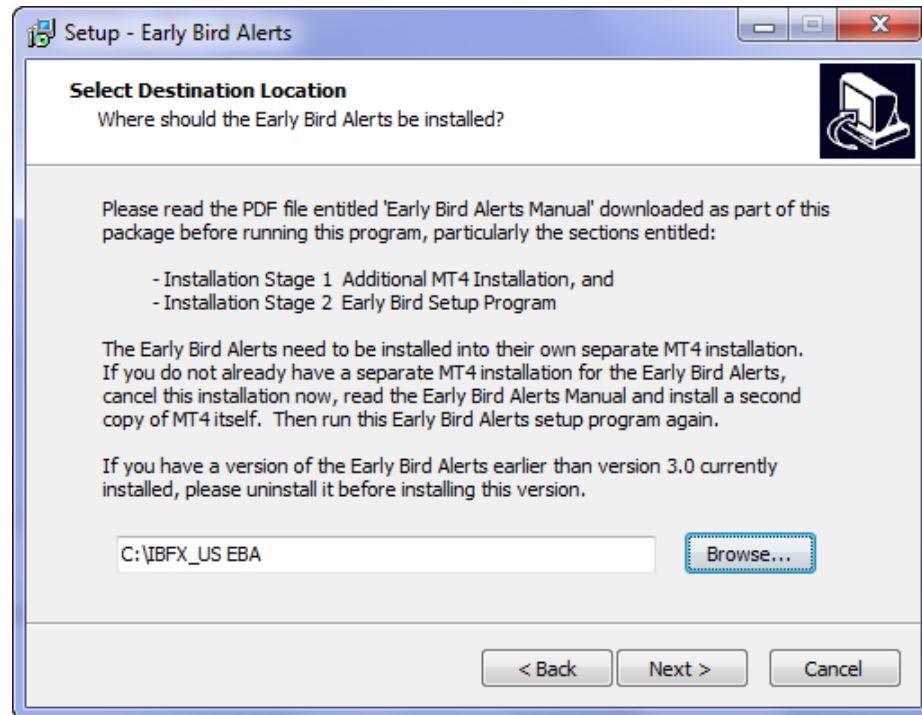


Fig 1 Setup (main window)

Run the EarlyBirdAlerts_3.2.0.0_Setup.exe program and install it into its own separate MT4 installation, the folder that MT4 itself was installed into in Stage 1 (Fig 1). The setup program does a comprehensive set of checks to ensure the Early Bird Alerts are being loaded into an appropriate MT4 folder. If you get any security warnings on the way through, accept them and keep going.

On successful completion, you can then delete all the files initially downloaded and extracted, including the manual, as the setup program has installed another copy of the manual in the MT4 directory and created a Start | All Programs | Forex Strategy Secrets menu entry pointing to the manual, the EBAAlertCredentials.exe program and the uninstallation folder.

2.3 Stage 3 - Configuring MT4 Scripts & Templates

2.3.1 a) Configure Expert Advisors

*** For the Expert Advisors to work it is very important that this is set up correctly ***

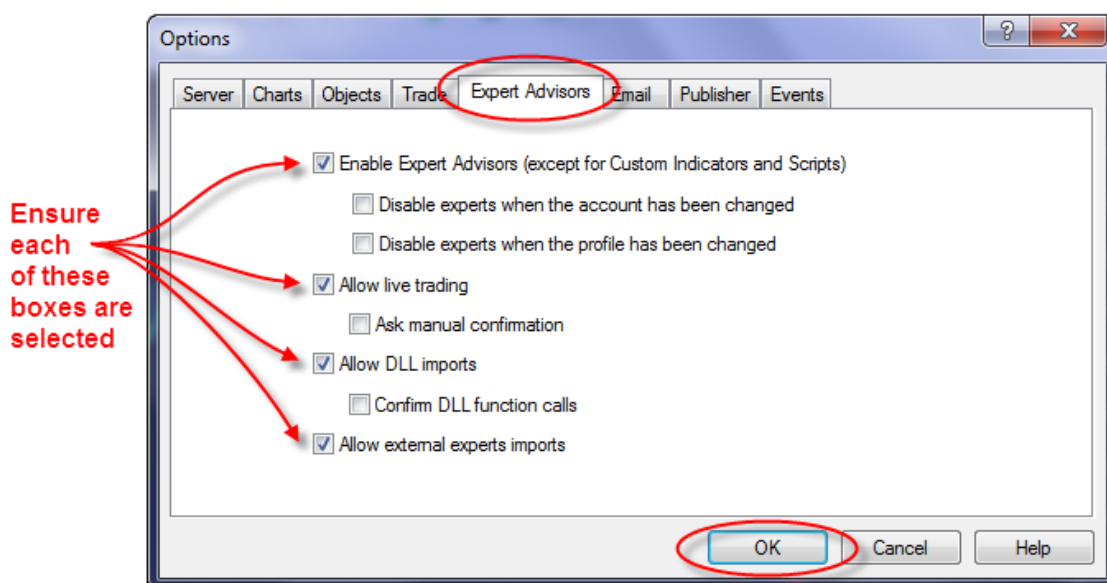


Fig 2 Expert Advisor Options

Run MT4 and bring up the Options window (Fig 2) by using the keyboard shortcut Ctrl+O or selecting Tools | Options from MT4's main menu. Then select the Expert Advisors tab, set the options as indicated and click OK.

Select Tools | Options and click on the Expert Advisors tab ...

2.3.2 b) Configure SMS Text and Email Messaging

SMS Text or Email Messaging is an optional feature - if you do not want to use it at this time then there is no need to set it up now. It can be set up at any time in the future should you later decide to use it.

This feature allows Early Bird Alerts to be sent as SMS messages to your mobile telephone or as emails to your normal email address, depending on the options taken on the next screen.

The details required are:

You will need to check to see if you have text message capability for your phone. Also it would be wise to consider having an unlimited texting facility on your service plan, depending on how many alerts you want to receive. For example, if you choose to only have the 1 hour and 4 hour alert signals sent to you, on 6 currency pairs you could get up to 30 alerts a day. If you just add the 30-minute timeframe this could increase the number of alerts by between 25 and 30 per day. This could be between 45 and 60 signals a day. For a month of trading you could get over 1,000 alerts. So be sure you either have unlimited texting on your phone, or be selective about how many currency pairs and timeframes you want to be notified of.

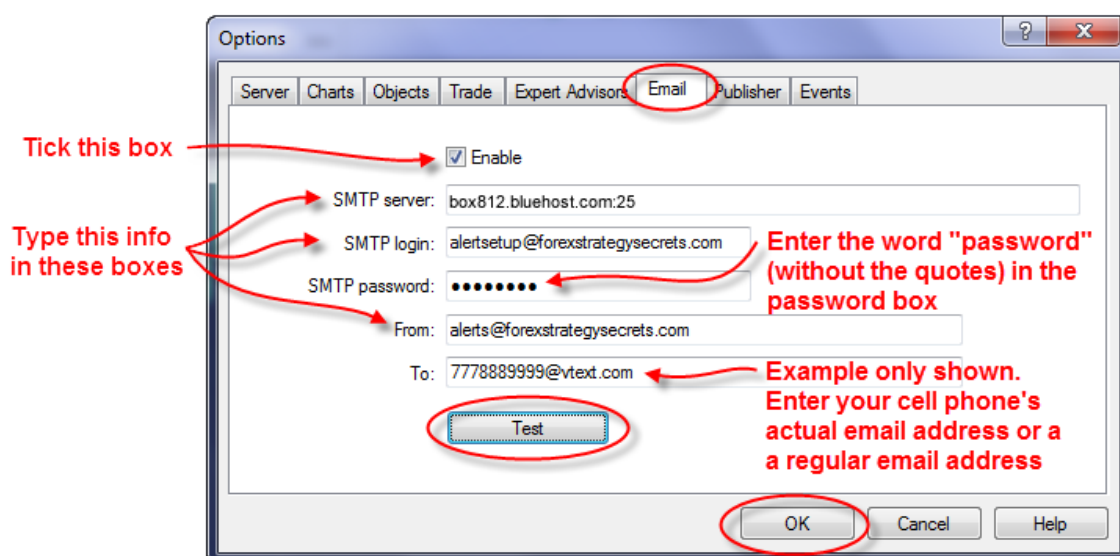


Fig 3 SMS/Email Options

Run MT4 and bring up the Options window by using the keyboard shortcut Ctrl+O or selecting Tools | Options from MT4's main menu. Then select the Email tab and complete it as indicated in Fig 3 below.

Select Tools | Options and click on the Email tab ...

2.3.3 c) Add Scripts to Favourites

The Early Bird Alerts setup program installed, amongst other things, three MT4 scripts:

- EBAAlertMonitor - an indicator which shows, on each chart, the timeframes & alert types (Email or Dialog) that have been defined for that currency pair
- EBAAlertNotifier - an Expert Advisor which actually locates an Early Bird Alert & notifies the display program
- EBAAlertPeriods - a script which initiates the Parameter Edit program

This step is to set these three scripts up as Favourites, which will make them easier to find later on.

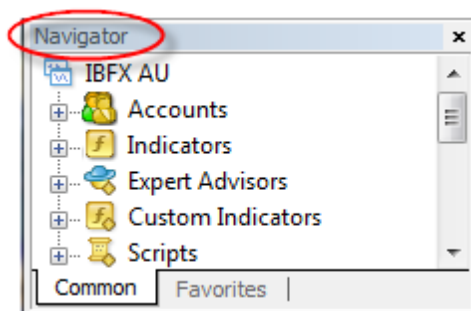


Fig 4 Navigator window

MT4 provides a Navigator window (refer Fig 4) - if you cannot see it on screen then go up to the main

menu bar and select View | Navigator (or use the keyboard shortcut Ctrl+N instead). You will see two tabs at the bottom of the window, Common & Favorites. The Favorites tab at this stage will be empty.

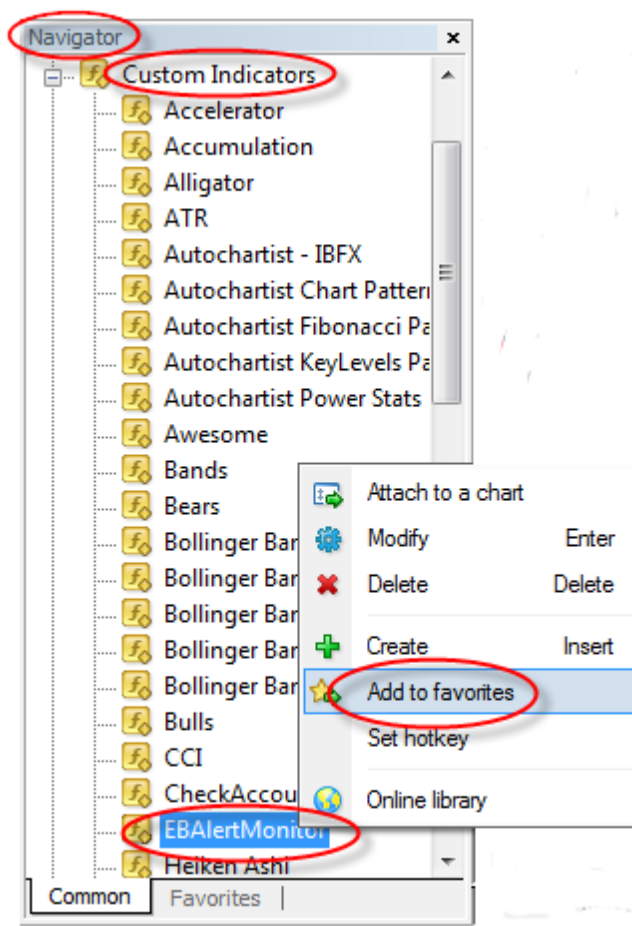


Fig 5 EBAAlertMonitor to Favorites

To add the EBAAlertMonitor to the Favorites window, go to the Navigator window, click on the "+" sign to the left of the Custom Indicators entry, scroll down to the EBAAlertMonitor entry and right-click on it, then left-click on the *Add to Favorites* entry in the pop-up menu (Fig 5).

To add the EBAAlertNotifier to the Favorites window, go to the Navigator window, click on the "+" sign to the left of the Expert Advisors entry, scroll down to the EBAAlertNotifier entry and right-click on it, then left-click on the *Add to Favorites* entry in the pop-up menu.

Then, to add the EBAAlertPeriods to the Favorites window, go to the Navigator window, click on the "+" sign to the left of the Scripts entry, scroll down to the EBAAlertPeriods entry and right-click on it,

then left-click on the *Add to Favorites* entry in the pop-up menu.

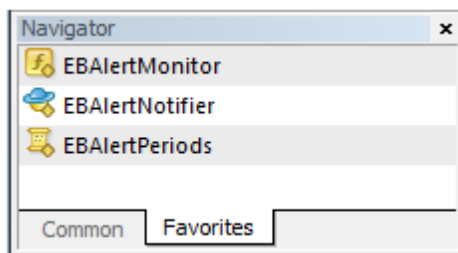


Fig 6 The completed Favorites tab.

The Favorites tab on the Navigator window should now look like Fig 6:

2.3.4 d) Add Favourites to Initial Chart

If you haven't done it already, delete all the default chart/feature/advertising windows that came with MT4 in the normal chart area - either click on the red close box on each window or press Ctrl+F4 repeatedly until they are all gone.

Right-click on a symbol (any will do) in MT4's Market Watch window and select the *Chart Window* option in the resulting pop-up menu.

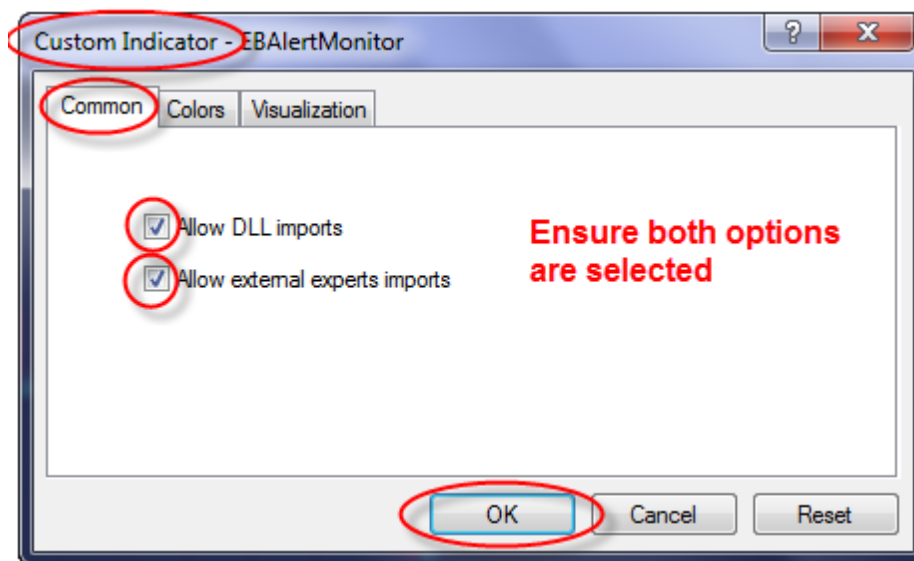


Fig 7 Custom Indicator - Common tab

Go to the Favorites tab in the Navigator window and click on the EBAAlertMonitor entry and, still holding the mouse down, drag it to the new chart window and release the button. This action will bring up the Custom Indicators screen - click on the Common tab if it is not already selected and ensure it is set to match Fig 7 below:

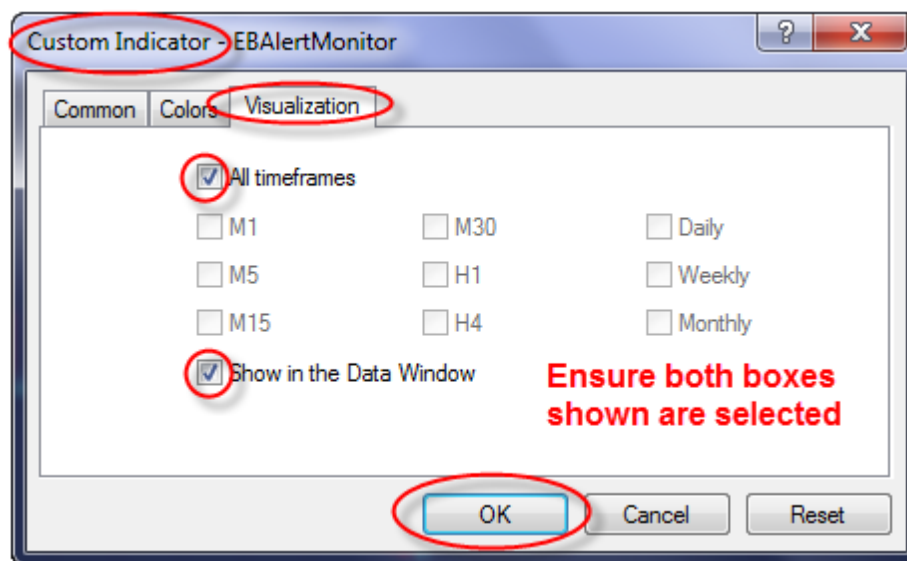


Fig 8 Custom Indicator - Visualisation tab

On the same Custom Indicators screen - click on the Visualization tab if it is not already selected and ensure it is set to match Fig 8 below:

At this point the chart window should display a message indicating that "The Early Bird Alert licence is currently invalid. Please contact support@forexstrategysecrets.com". Ignore this for the moment, it will be addressed in the next section (Stage 4 - Configuring Early Bird Parameters).

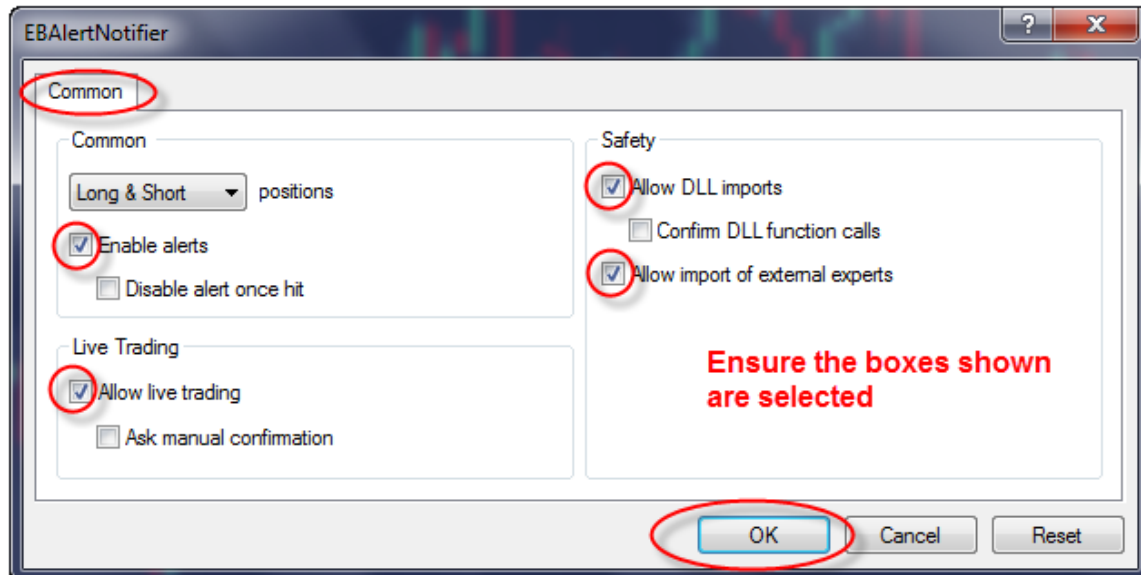


Fig 9 Expert Advisor

Go to the Favorites tab in the Navigator window and click on the EBAAlertNotifier entry and, still holding the mouse down, drag it to the new chart window and release the button. This action will bring up the following screen - click on the Common tab if it is not already selected and ensure it is set to match Fig 9 below:

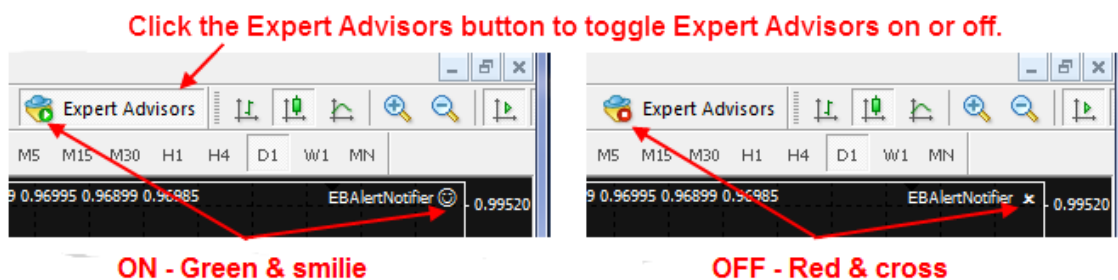


Fig 10 Expert Advisors ON/OFF toggle.

Ensure the Expert Advisors are ON and active (see Fig 10 following).

No further setup action is required for the script *EBAAlertPeriods* at this point.

2.3.5 e) Create a Default Chart Template

This step will create a default template with the Early Bird indicator and Early Bird Expert Advisor already attached, so that when a new chart window is opened it will have these automatically applied, thus saving you adding them (as you did in the last stage) to each new chart.

Now is the time to make any cosmetic changes to the Early Bird Alerts charts that you would like, such as chart styles (OHLC, line, candlesticks etc) and colours for all chart components (F8), but bear in mind that you will not look at these screens very often - you would usually only see them when you want to change the Early Bird parameters.

As you will not need the prices to display on these charts, one combination you could choose that gives a completely blank chart area is to:

- Go to the File | Charts and select the *Line Chart* option
- Right-click on the chart & select *Properties* (or just press F8) and set the following colours:
 - Background to *DimGray* (or another darker colour),
 - Foreground to *White*,
 - Line Graph to *None* (display the colour selection boxes & select the *None* option box at the top)

When you are ready, go to MT4's main menu bar and select Charts | Template | SaveTemplate and save the current screen with the name "EBAAlerts" (without the quotes).

Then go to MT4's main menu bar and select Charts | Template | SaveTemplate again and save the current screen with the name "Default" (without the quotes). Answer Yes when asked "*Default.tpl already exists. Do you want to replace it?*".

You can create as many chart windows as you wish now (or later) by right-clicking on a currency pair in the Market Watch window and selecting the "Chart Window" option from the pop-up menu.


Only create one chart window for each currency pair you are interested in. The Early Bird Alerts will process & generate alerts for all timeframes requested in the Parameters Screen for that currency pair when processing that chart window. If multiple charts are opened for the one currency pair, duplicate copies of the alerts will be needlessly generated.

2.4 Stage 4 - Configuring Early Bird Parameters

This step validates the licence and allows for the particular parameters preferred by you to be selected individually or in bulk for each chart defined.

Go to Windows Start | All Programs | Forex Strategy Secrets menu and select the EBAAlertCredentials program. Enter the Email Address you use for the <http://forexprofitclassroom.org> site and the Facilities Key that was emailed to you when you signed up for these alerts. The Facilities Key can also be obtained from the Profile page on the <http://forexprofitclassroom.org> site. Select the Submit button and the details will be verified against the Forex Strategy Secrets database


(see Fig 11 following).

Go to MT4's Navigator window and select the Favorites tab. Click on the EBAAlertPeriods entry and drag and drop it onto a chart. You will then be presented with the Edit Early Bird Parameters screen where you can update globally all screens defined to date to one particular parameter setting. It is suggested that you use the *UpdateAll* feature to update all existing charts to your most common configuration and afterwards modify individual charts to suit (Fig 12). To quickly see the alerts in action set a *Show Dialog* alert on a 1 Minute timeframe and with 6 or 7 charts open you should shortly have a steady stream of alerts coming through.

Refer to the Parameters Window section following for a more detailed explanation of updating parameters individually or globally at any time.

To complete the installation, close the Early Bird Alerts display window and also close the Early Bird Alerts MT4 instance, then restart the MT4 program - the Early Bird Alerts display window will start automatically when the MT4 program starts.

3 Parameters Window

The Early Bird Parameters screen allows the user to set which type of Early Bird Alert (by Email, by Dialog or both) is required for each of the nine timeframes available for a particular currency pair. Such a setting for one symbol can be applied globally to all currency pairs (not just those symbols currently loaded but to all that have been used in recent history).

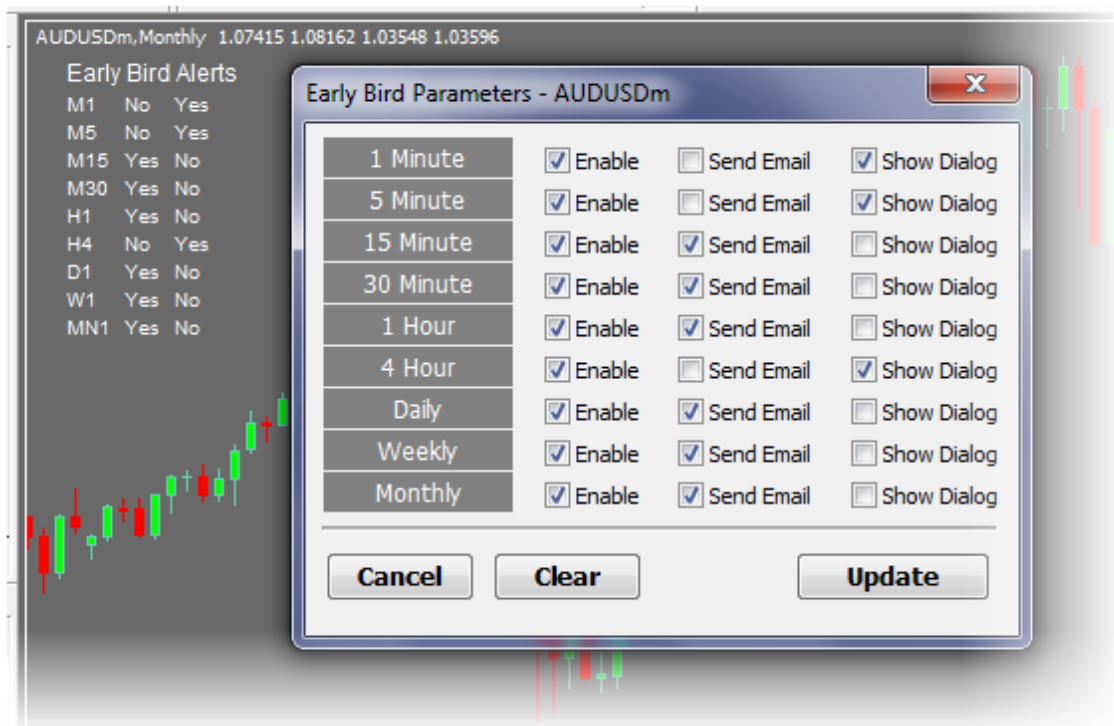


Fig 13 Basic Parameter Screen with corresponding Indicator display showing behind ...

To activate the Early Bird Parameter edit program, first go to MT4 and activate the chart window for the symbol you are currently interested in. Then go to MT4's Navigator window, select the Favorites tab and then left-click the EBAAlertPeriods entry, hold and drag the cursor over the chart window and release the mouse. Alternatively you can go to MT4's Navigator window, select the Favorites tab and then right-click the EBAAlertPeriods entry and left-click the "Attach to Chart" entry in the resulting pop-up menu. The basic Parameter window for the chart's symbol will be displayed (Fig 13).

If you only want a Dialog alert, click the Show Dialog checkbox once or twice.

If you only want an Email alert, click the Send Email checkbox once or twice.

If you want both types of alert, click the Enable checkbox once or twice.

Whether you have to click once or twice depends on the previous setting of that row.

The **Cancel** button will close the screen without making any changes.

The **Clear** button will clear the screen display only (these changes will not be applied until the **Update** button is selected).

The **Update** button will apply any changes made.

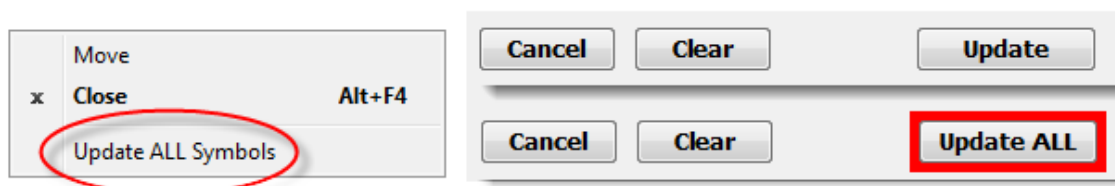


Fig 14 Use Update All Symbols to toggle between Update & Update ALL modes

If you right-click in the title-bar of the Early Bird Parameter edit program, a menu will be displayed with an **Update ALL Symbols** option to toggle between the **Update** and **Update ALL** modes, as in Fig 14 following:

In *Update* mode the configuration changes will only be applied to the currency pair in that particular chart, whereas in *Update ALL* mode the configuration changes will be applied to all currency pairs that have been used in recent history.

Only create one chart window for each currency pair you are interested in. The Early Bird Alerts will process & generate alerts for all timeframes requested in the Parameters Screen for that currency pair when processing that chart window. If multiple charts are opened for the one currency pair, duplicate copies of the alerts will be needlessly generated.

For the technically-minded, the parameter settings for each currency pair are held in an MT4 Global Variable as a nine digit number where 1 represents None, 2 represents Email only, 3 represents Dialog only & 4 represents both and timeframes are read left to right from M1 through MN1. Do not modify the Global Variables directly.

After the initial setup, if a new Chart Window is opened the system will, after a few moments, automatically apply a default parameter setting of a Dialog alert for all nine timeframes for that symbol, which of course can then be edited.

4 Alerts Window

To start the Early Bird Alerts process, ensure the Early Bird Alerts screen display program is not running and start up the Early Bird Alerts own MT4 program - the MT4 program will automatically start the Early Bird Alerts screen display program.

To avoid disrupting the real-time operation of MT4 itself, the start of the Early Bird processing for each chart is staggered, taking 3 minutes to completely load 10 charts, or 6 minutes to load 20 charts or 10 minutes to fully load 30 charts and so on..


Only one instance of the Early Bird Alerts can be run at a time on any one machine.

To stop the Early Bird Alerts process either:

- close the Early Bird Alerts own MT4 program, which will then automatically close the Early Bird Alerts screen display program, or
- close the Early Bird Alerts screen display program manually first, then close the Early Bird Alerts own MT4 program.

The Early Bird Alerts display window maintains a rolling list of the last 300 alerts received since the program was started.


For each alert found, the Early Bird Alerts display program shows the time (either the broker's server time or your local time), the symbol, the timeframe, the position long/short and the bid price (Fig 15).

If you left-click on the header of the Time column, the column will toggle between displaying the Time (Local) and the Time(Server) (Fig 16).

Options are available:

- to generate a beep on receipt of a new alert
- for a minimised alert window to be automatically restored on receipt of a new alert
- for the alert window to display on top of other windows
- to hide the Long/Short and/or Price columns to increase the screen display area available for other programs

These options are saved when the program closes and restored when the program restarts.

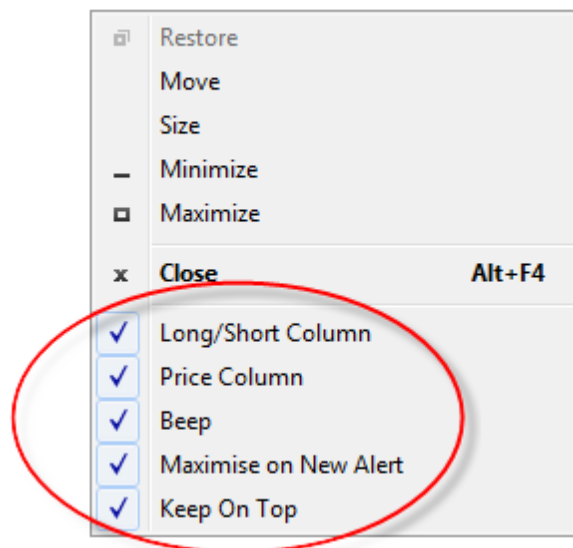


Fig 17 Options available

A right-click on the title bar of the Early Bird Alerts screen display window will bring up the following Options menu (Fig 17):

The options are illustrated here. The Price column is not used all the time and can be turned off to gain more screen real-estate. The Long/Short column effectively duplicates the information from the red and blue icons to the left of the Time column, and again can be turned off to save space (Fig 18):

5 Troubleshooting

If the install does not seem to start working immediately, make sure you have about 6 or 7 charts defined and then set the parameters for all charts to give you a Dialog alert on the One Minute timeframe - that's likely to give you an alert every one or two minutes!

If the install then does not start working go back over the installation instructions carefully.

If it seems like nothing is working at all, go to MT4's main tool bar and check the Expert Advisors are ON - the icon on the button is all Green, with no Red!

If the Early Bird Alerts MT4 instance is shutdown forcibly or the machine crashes, MT4 may be unable to complete the deletion of those of its Global Variables that should be deleted when it shuts down or it may be unable to complete the saving of those Global Variables that should be saved on shutdown. This will be recognised when the Early Bird Alerts MT4 application is started again and the following message will be raised: *"MT4 was not shutdown cleanly. Please close both the Early Bird Alerts & its MT4 program and then restart the MT4 program."*. Close both programs as requested and restart the MT4 program. If on restarting MT4 comes up but the Early Bird Alerts window does not, then select *Tools | Global Variables* and delete the variable *EBA_RestartRequired* if it is present.

In an extreme case all the MT4 Global Variables can be deleted (go to MT4's main menu, select *Tools | Global Variables*, press Ctrl+A to highlight them all and then press the Delete key). It would usually be sufficient to delete only the MT4 Global Variables that start with a prefix of *EBA_Instance*. If you have 15 charts open, there will be 15 of these variables, named from *EBA_Instance_0* through to *EBA_Instance_14*. Use the Parameter Edit screen to re-enter the licence details if requested and to reset the alert parameters for each chart.

It is noted that MT4 itself will, as part of its own housekeeping, automatically delete any Global Variables that have not been accessed (either read or written) within the last 4 weeks. Should this happen then, as above, use the Parameter Edit screen to re-enter the licence details if requested and to reset the alert parameters for each chart.

- Go to MT4's main menu & run Charts | Template | Remove Template and select the EBAAlert entry
- Go to MT4's Navigator window, select the Favorites tab & for each of the three entries (EBAAlertMonitor, EBAAlertNotifier, EBAAlertPeriods) right-click that entry & select *Delete from Favorites*.
- Go to the <MT4 Directory>\uninstallEBAAlerts folder and run the program *unins000.exe* which will uninstall the files and registry entries which setup originally created
